WHITE WINES

Reserve Saint Marc, Sauvignon Blanc £11.95

Foncalieu, Languedoc, France

Modern vinification techniques have transformed the quality this wine produced in the Languedoc region. Typical gooseberry aromas and fresh acidity.

Chardonnay Reserva, Hugo Casanova £13.95

Maule Valley, Chile

From the Maule Valley, this wine is golden yellow in colour, with intense aromas of citric fruits and a pleasant hint of French oak. Well balanced with an excellent body, buttery vanilla and a hint of delicate wood.

Gavi Di Gavi, Villa Casseta £18.75

Piemonte, Italy

One of the most important dry white wines of Piedmont from the wine producing area of Gavi. Gavi extends from the village of Novi Ligure to the lower hills of the Ligurian Apennines. Gavi di Gavi, however, is produced exclusively in the village of Gavi. This classic un-oaked white has deliciously floral aromas with ripe white peach flavours and zippy acidity.

Blaye Cotes de Bordeaux Sauvignon, Chateau Haut Terrier £24

Bright and beautiful in colour with aromas of banana and lemon. Grapes are harvested for 4 months to give a fresh and smoky taste. A lovely Bordeaux Blanc.

Sauvignon Blanc, Mission Estate £25.50

The colour is pale yellow with green tints, the ripe bouquet is of tropical fruit, citrus, passionfruit and gooseberry. The palate is crisp, fruity and dry, with a clean lingering finish. Established in 1851 by the French Marist religious order, Mission Estate Winery is New Zealands oldest winemaker.

Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine Pascal Renaud £30

Made from the world-renowned Chardonnay grape. Shows the incomparable finesse of the great wines of Burgundy. Mineral on the nose with citrus fruit flavour to give a complex and very well balanced wine.

RED WINES

Merlot Del Veneto, Rocca Estate £11.95

Italy

This wine has a youthful, fruity and user friendly style which comes from the typically soft, fleshy character of the Merlot grape!

Les Fontanelles, Pinot Noir £13.95 Languedoc, France Deep-coloured and full-bodied with the classic strawberry fruit flavours of the Pinot Noir grown in the cool hilly vineyard areas of South of France. The inclusion of some oak-aged wine in the final blend adds extra depth and complexity.

Malbec Reserva, Raza £19.50

Argentina

Purple red with ruby red hues. The aroma is reminiscent of red fruits such as plums and black fruits. On the palate the wine is full, long and well balanced. The ageing in oak barrels for several months gives the wine vanilla, chocolate and tobacco aromas and the finishing touch provides the complexity in the bouquet, which is characteristic of this variety

Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Carlos Serres £23

Black cherry-red with light tawny hues. Its aromas and flavours preserve a perfect balance between it fruity origins and the maturity achieved through ageing (16 month Oak Barrel). Fine elegance, an impressive finish from this famous Haro Bodegas.

Lirac, 'Roc-Epine' Domaine Lafond £28

A powerful well-built wine, a deep ruby colour with violet tints. A complex nose of vanilla, fruits and cherries. The attack is rich and firm, with the mouth expressing long lasting nuances of vanilla and pepper. Smooth and rich

Merlot-Cabernet Franc 'Jewelstone', Mission Estate £48

The sweet berry and spice, aromas on the nose show on the palate with explosive intensity. Very long on the finish with silky tannins. The Cabernet Sauvignon is off a unique premium stony site with a good proportion of fine silt phases in the topsoil. In an exclusive blind tasting in Hong Kong, that included eight legendary Bordeaux wines, Mission's Jewelstone Cabernet-Merlot has been ranked in the top three - a sensational result that stunned the participants.

SPARKLING

Champagne Hemerence Brut £30

A subtle marriage of delicacy, freshness and pleasure. Made from 80% Pinot Noir and 20% Chardonnay using the traditional method. The predominance of Pinot noir is apparent in the bright, berry fruit aromas and a rich, mouth-filling texture. The Chardonnay lends liveliness and provides a pleasantly long, clean finish.

Lallier Grand Cru Champagne, Grande Reserve Brut £46.95

The Lallier Cuvee grande Reserve is produced using grapes solely grown in Champagnes grand Cru vineyards and is cellar aged for a minimum of 24 months. A blend of 65% Pinot Noir and 35% Chardonnay it is well rounded and pleasant with a buttery brioche nose and hints of fruity apricot.

Pol Roger Brut Reserve Champagne £46.95

From the favourite Champagne house of Winston Churchill comes this beautifully golden straw yellow champagne. While not being overly fizzy or foamy this champagnes fine bubbles just keep sparkling. A bouquet of floral and ripe fruit aromas mesh well with its light oaky roasted aroma. Pol Roger Reserves rich vinous grapey flavour is thirst-quenching on the palate with a superb taste of brioche.

Pannier Brut Vintage Champagne £54

The gold color reflects the 5 years ageing before release. Persistent minuscule bubbles denote the finesse of this cuvee. The splendid robe of lingering bubbles is as unctuous as it is inviting. On the nose, this wine is very fresh with hints of white flowers, young white peaches with exotic overtones of citrus fruit. On the palate, the attack is frank, the structure and finesse lead into a long and elegant after taste.

Prosecco Millesimato Borgo Gritti, Extra Dry £16.95

Spumante made from the exclusive selection of prosecco grapes. Pale straw-yellow colour, fine perlage, rich and fragrant bouquet, dry to the taste with a pleasantly-bitter undertone.
